

# Info Flash: Decommissioning of CAP/MAP architecture

Luxembourg, 10 August 2009

The NYSE Euronext group has announced that the official decommissioning of its CAP/MAP architecture will take place at the end of September 2009.

Access to the Luxembourg market will therefore no longer be possible via this architecture.

To ensure continuity of service, data from the Luxembourg Stock Exchange have been integrated into the EMF Feed (Euronext Multicast Feed) accessible from the MMBA architecture (Multi-Market Broadband Access). It has also been integrated into the SFTI architecture (Secure Financial Transaction Infrastructure) through the new NYSE Euronext protocols UTP-MD and UTP Direct.

All ISVs must have migrated their access to one of the following architectures:

SFTI Architecture		
Connectivity	Protocol	Feed
SFTI	UTP-MD	Market Data
SFTI - CCG	UTP-Direct	SLE (Order Entry)

MMBA Architecture		
Connectivity	Protocol	Feed
MMBA	EMF* or UTP-MD	Market Data
MMBA	MMTP or Fix-En UTP-Direct	SLE (Order Entry)

\* For reasons of limited bandwidth, retransmission functionalities will not be available for the securities of the Luxembourg Stock Exchange in the EMF feeds.

Note: The MMBA architecture is no longer deployed by NYSE Euronext and is accessible only by customers already having such a connectivity. During 2010, this architecture will be also decommissioned. The target architectures and protocols are SFTI, UTP-MD and UTP Direct.
